



Market Lamb / Goat Supply List Suggestions

This is a list to get you started. There may be additional items needed as the year progresses. Other expenses can include things like medical care and show entry fees.

Blanket – Weaver Pro Cool Blanket is recommended due to our constantly changing weather.

Muzzle

Halter, Collar and/or Show chain – Training and show lead for goats/lambs

Water Bucket

Mud Boots – for cleaning pen / bathing animal

Rubber Mat or Bedding for pen/stall

Feeder/Feed Bucket/Trough

Feed – Commonly used brands are Purina, Jacoby and Lindner

Hay – Alfalfa or Coastal, depending on recommendation from Ag teachers

Supplements – Ag teachers will recommend brand and when to start

Optional – Vetericyn Gel Spray for wound care

Cleaning Supplies – Stiff-Bristled Brush/Broom, Metal Scraper, Bleach, Dust Pan, 5 gal Bucket

Grooming Supplies – Unscented/dye-free baby wipes, Grooming brush, Wool card (leg comb), Mild Shampoo

Show Number Holder

Drench Gun

Show/Tack Box – to hold equipment/supplies

Air blower or dryer

Electric fan

Time – To care for and tame/train/exercise

Dyne/Amino Acids – Show day additives

Whitening Shampoo – Used day of show

Fungicide Shampoo – Used to wash animal after show
