Swine purchase/validation: The night of the meeting was the last night to give Ag teachers swine purchase money. It was announced that all animals that enter the barn **MUST** be properly vaccinated **PRIOR** to coming into the barn. If you aren't sure what is required ask an AG teacher. Second the entire pen must be disinfected rails included before placing an animal in it. New hogs that are purchased need to be either on Linders 632 or Essentials 58920 MDX. If you are getting your hogs through the ag teachers please have feed by Friday! Hogs will be delivered Saturday morning look on remind for exact time.

Swine Validation will take place Wednesday November 10th at the HCISD Ag Farm from 4-6pm.
